Access Hundreds of Online Courses with Learn4Life and Your Library

The library now offers access to the online learning tool called Learn4Life. Learn4Life offers hundreds of six week online courses taught by live instructors. Classes include interactive time, two lessons per week, quizzes, and a final. Students who pass the courses receive a certificate, making it a convenient option for occupations that require ongoing professional development. Similar courses might cost \$100 or more through other avenues.

Course offerings, descriptions, and student reviews are available on the Learn4Life website, which can be accessed through the library's home page at <http://christiancounty.lib.mo.us>. Click the Learn4Life banner, and browse courses that include everything from digital photography to accounting fundamentals, Windows 8 to navigating divorce. If you find a course you'd like to take, click "enroll" and follow onscreen instructions. New class sessions begin approximately once per month, with the next session for many courses beginning De-

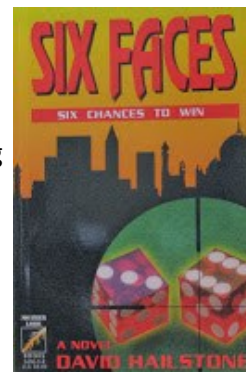

Title: Six Faces: Six Chances to Win

Genre: Historical Fiction

Book Description: In Kuwait City in the fall of 1989, a year before the Persian Gulf War begins, a friendship begins between two American expatriates and former Marines living in Kuwait. A partnership is formed between the two when the older man shows the new guy in town how to win big money shooting craps in private games using the laws of probability to their advantage. When Kuwait is invaded in August 1990, the men find themselves chained to artillery pieces as human shields on enemy lines. They scramble to find a way to safety, only to be forced into setting up a private game for a gang of marauders just as the Allied Forces are about to invade the city. After teaching the soldiers of fortune how to play craps, the men work their way into this once-in-a-lifetime game where millions of dollars worth of stolen property is on the table.

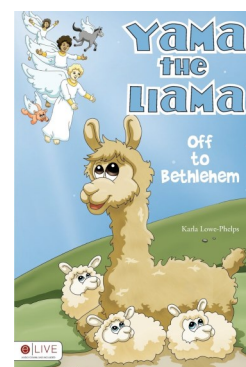
