Find Your Next Favorite Book with NoveList and Your Library

Christian County Library staff are regularly asked, "Can you recommend other books to read if I like...?" and "What's the next title in this series?" To answer these questions, we turn to a secret weapon, a database called NoveList. The richly-detailed information available in NoveList is all about books. The best part: you need only internet access and your library card to use it yourself.

Visit <http://christiancountylibrary.org/databases.html> to try it out. Click on the "NoveList" link in the alphabetical list, then enter your library card number. Not sure where to start? Choose a featured bestseller from the front page to learn more about it. Library copies of bestsellers often have waiting lists, so NoveList recommends other titles to read while you wait. Nothing appealing in the featured bestsellers? Click on a genre in the left sidebar to get top recommendations in that category.

Want a personalized search? Type in keywords that appeal to you: "Victorian murder mystery," "American political thriller," or "teen vampire fiction." You'll get hundreds of titles and series, each with a plot synopsis, reviews from trusted sources like "Publishers Weekly," information about the author, and whether or not the book is part of a series.

Search for your favorite author. Under the "Lists and Articles" tab, find author "read-alikes." More than just a list of other books that might appeal you, it tells you exactly how recommended titles relate to your favorites so you can decide which you'll really enjoy. Limit your results by reading level, date of publication, or by choosing sub-categories such as genre or subject. Use NoveList's appeal factors to discover books that are just your style. Choose a tone like "atmospheric" or "thought-provoking." Select a writing style like "gritty" or "compelling." It's like having access to well-read librarian from your home computer.

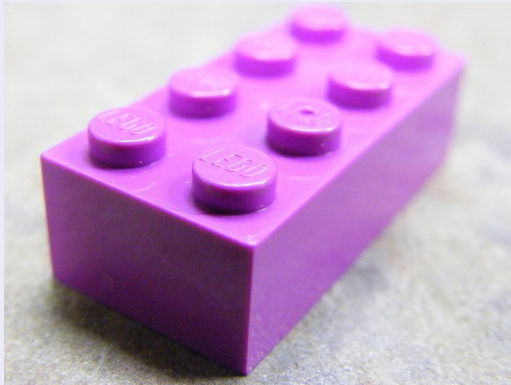
