## LIBRARY FOUNDATION RECEIVES \$100,000 DONATION

The Stanley and Elaine Ball Foundation gave \$100,000 to the Christian County Library Foundation. The money will be used to fund a new children's area for the Christian County Library in the future. This marks the largest donation by far to the relatively new Christian County Library Foundation.

The Christian County Library Foundation was formed in 2013 to raise funds towards expanding access to library facilities and services in Christian County. Voters rejected tax increases for the same purpose in 2009 and 2010. The Stanley and Elaine Ball Foundation announced the gift after library director Geri Olmstead and several members of the foundation board and library board of trustees presented their cause on October 7. "We are so excited and grateful," said Olmstead.



Stanley Ball was once a Nixa resident, and was the first president of the Nixa Community Foundation. He established the Stanley and Elaine Ball Charitable Foundation after his wife Elaine died in 2005. The foundation's goal is to help those less fortunate and improve the communities that Stanley and Elaine loved. Mr. Ball passed away earlier this year at 97. The Balls' daughter, Jo Arcudia, said of the donation to the Christian County Library Foundation, "We hope this will encourage others to support the library and its potential growth throughout Christian County."

The current library was built in 1972 to serve a population of approximately 15,000 people. Christian County has grown to more than 80,000 people in 2015. While voters in 1971 approved a 0.20-cent tax levy, Hancock Amendment rollbacks mean the library collects only .0887-cents per \$100 in assessed value. The library hopes to ask voters to restore the 0.20-cent levy rate in the future to fund expansion at its branch in Ozark and establish new branches in Nixa, Clever, and Sparta.
