- **Register for the Oceans of Possibilities Reading Challenge**

After signing into the Beanstack app, tap **Discover** ( to find the Summer Reading Challenge. Scroll down and tap Join Challenge. Now start reading!

- **Log Your Reading** 
  - There are several ways to log and track your reading using the Beanstack app. Here's the quickest, easiest method:
    - Tap + , then **Reading**, then **Log** Without a Title. Type in the number of minutes spent reading or listening to a book, then tap **Done**.
