

Register to vote at any Christian County Library community branch location


You will need proof of identification. We can accept any of the following:

- ID issued by the federal government, state of Missouri, agency of the state, local election authority, or institution of higher education in Missouri
- Current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, or government check
- Any government document that shows your name and address

No reservations or calling ahead is required to regiter to vote.

You count!

Everyone pays taxes to the federal government (whether or not you are counted in the census) but the census determines how much of that federal money comes back to Christian County to pay for things like roads, health care, and schools. Make sure our tax dollars come back to help our community by completing the census survey for your household. It only takes 5 minutes to complete the census either online at **2020census.gov** or over the phone at (844) 330-2020. Need internet access? Visit any Christian County Library location.



The deadline to complete the census is October 31, 2020.
