Considering a Mail-in ballot for the November election?

Register to vote at any Christian County Library community branch location

Register to vote at any Christian County Community Library branch location. Please bring with you any of the following:

- ID issued by the federal government, state of Missouri, agency of the state, local election authority, or institution of higher education in Missouri
- Current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, or government check
- Any government document that shows your name and address

If you are voting with a mail-in ballot, we can notarize them for free!

Call your closest library branch to set-up a time to meet with a notary (a mask will be required).

- The deadline to vote is Wednesday, October 7
- The deadline to request a ballot by mail is Wednesday, October 21
- The November election is Tuesday, November 3

You count!

Everyone pays taxes to the federal government (whether or not you are counted in the census) but the census determines how much of that federal money comes back to Christian County to pay for things like roads, health care, and schools. Make sure our tax dollars come back to help our community by completing the census survey for your household. It only takes 5 minutes to complete the census either online at 2020census.gov or over the phone at (844) 330-2020. Need internet access? Visit any Christian County Library location.
